	A superb Aussie Shiraz with masses of juicy blackcurrant fruit and a charismatic, smooth, spicy and peppery finish.					
24	Château Guiot Cabardés	France	2008			£18.00
	A blend of Grenache and Syrah grapes this beautifully scented wine offers spicy rich berry flavours. Often hailed by the wine critics.					
25	Yering Frog Pinot Noir	Australia	2007			£21.00
	Partial fermentation in aged French oak gives this wine savoury undertones which balance perfectly with the ripe raspberry and black cherry flavours.

	A rich, round, mellow Merlot from St Emilion, Bordeaux's most historic wine region that is full of style and elegance.					
27	Fleurie, Labouré-Roi Beaujolais Cru	France	2007			£25.50
	Deep ruby in colour with a highly aromatic nose suggesting red fruits alongside violet and rose floral notes. With strawberry jam flavours on the palate, some say Fleurie is the most elegant of the Beaujolais Crus. Supple and silky, this would be perfect when served with cured pork meats.					
28	Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rhône	France	2007			£30.00
	Aged in the famous cellars of Ogier Caves des Papes in the heart of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth and lingering finish.					
29	Barolo 'Galarej' Fontanafredda Barolo	Italy	2004			£42.00
	This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure and fully capable of withstanding the test of time. The bouquet is clean, full and intense, with typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses and tar.					
30	La Réserve de Léoville-Barton Bordeaux	France	2001			£48.00
	The second wine of Château Leoville-Barton. The 2000 Grand Vin received 96 Parker Points, and the second wine represents sensational value for the vintage. Grapes are hand-picked and fermented in large oak vats before undergoing 15 months ageing in oak barrels. The subsequent wine is concentrated but elegant, with ripe fruits and delicate perfume – a claret of true class
